What should I clean?

You must clean any 'high touch' surfaces – those that drivers and/or passengers touch regularly. These include:



Steering wheel and controls



Keys



Door handles (including boot)



Window controls



Rear view mirror adjuster



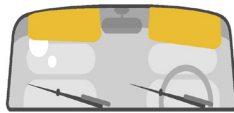
Payment terminals



Handbrake



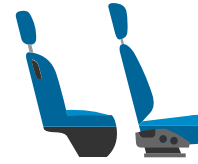
Gearstick



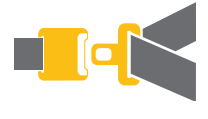
Visors



Internal grab handles



Seats



Seatbelts and clips

What cleaning products should I use?

- Use products containing bleach, alcohol or hydrogen peroxide. If these are not available, use a disinfectant.



When should I clean my vehicle?

- Clean high touch surfaces touched by passengers after each passenger leaves and before the next trip starts.
- Clean high touch surfaces only touched by the driver at the end of each driver's shift.



- Keep a record of what is cleaned and when. Make sure your cleaning records are always up to date.
